Brewing your own beer is a rewarding hobby, but is not without risks. Furthermore, should you ever suspect that the equipment you are using may not be suitable for safe brewing practice, cease using the questionable equipment immediately.

Brewing may involve large, heavy vessels of liquid (normally very hot – but even empty, cool vessels can cause injuries), and in the case of brewstands.com home brew systems, they are often at elevated levels. <a href="NEVER STAND">NEVER STAND</a>; NOR ALLOW CHILDREN, PETS, OR OTHER PERSONS TO STAND NEAR OR UNDER YOUR HOME BREW SYSTEM WHETHER IN USE OR WHILE STORED.
